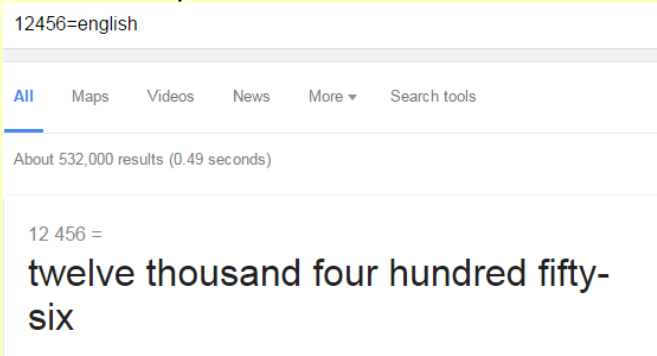

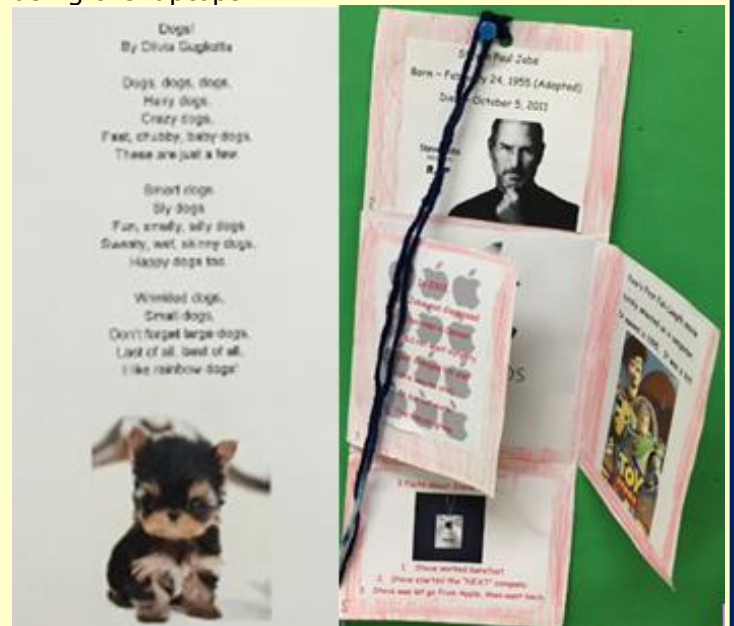
Chrome Tip

Innovative work being done at White Rock using the laptops!



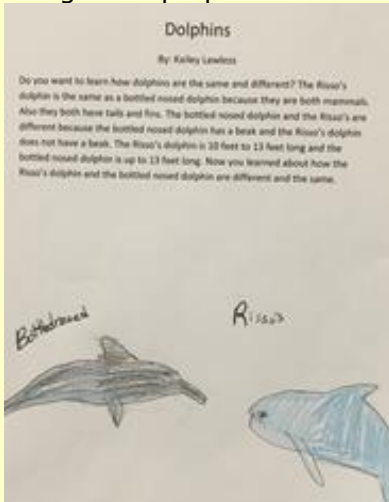
iPads & Legos

Creative work being done at Stanlick using the laptops!

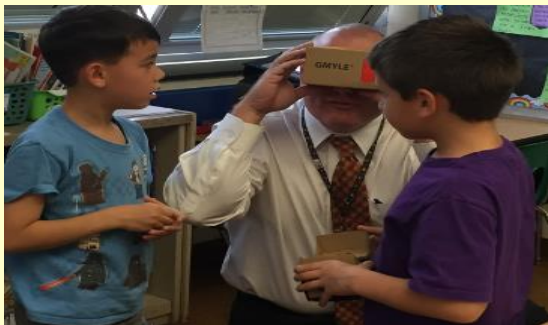


Highlights
